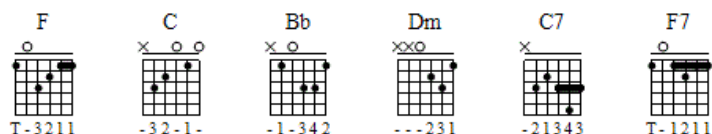


Auld lang syne
